

As a college student in the 1980s. Ramesh participated in one hundred and fifty inter-collegiate debate competitions and won prisez in all of them. he has been serving as an editor, printer & publisher of the prevalent Kannada Magazine "Spardha Prapancha" for the past 12 years.

His interests include environment, travel, reading, music, theatre & short film making. Considering his contributions in the field of Environment, Arts, Literature & Social work, the Government of Karnataka honoured him with "Karnataka State Youth Award" 1988–89). This poetry collection has also been translated to foreign languages. Some of his Poems are also included in the syllabus for the Graduate and Master's programs in the universities."The Roots" a short film is conceptualized & directed by Nagathihalli Ramesh is a new and refreshing experiment in Kannada language that captures in depth experiences of life & nature. Another fresh experiment is a collection of unique poems of Nagathihalli Ramesh narrated to the mellifluous music of flute titled 'Tili' (Kannada) and 'Pure' (English). Flutist Bapu Padmanabha has conceptualised and provided music to this project. Yet another musical contribution is 'Pada Pada Charita' in collaboration with S. R Ramakrishna and Jenni.Ramesh is popularly known as "Avvanni" amongst his friends. "Jeeva jeevada haadu" in kannada, "Uyirin Uyiru Pattu" in Tamil (Translated by Nalla Thambi) and "Song of every life" in English have been set to music by SR Ramakrishna and released as audio CDs with music by Mandolin Prasad, Orchastration by Kishan Murthy. His other Kannada albums include "Bayala Kannadi", 2. "Manada Minchu", "Olithu", and "Male Kaavu"Nagathihalli
































































































































Start of Aapni Pathshala

Constable Dharvir Jakhar, Belt No. 1014 posted at Women Police Station, Churu has always been agitated to the dire condition of the children of the slum dwellers and the children deprived of the Education from the nomadic families.

Achievements of operated Aapni Pathshala

- So far about 600 children have been linked to education, including UP. The children of about 150 laborers who came from MP, Bihar to work in the medical college in Churu were also involved, who studied during the formation of medical college for two years and then went back to their states.
- At present, informally 200 children are studying regularly mostly from nomadic families other than Rajasthan.
- Without any government assistance, but only with public support, these nomadic children involved in begging and child labour are fed daily lunch along with education apart from dress. Everything is free including bags, stationary, means of transportation.
- With repeated consultations about family planning, many women have done operations on one or three children.
